The Community Connections Society of Southeast BC and Interior Health have partnered with UBC to offer the Parent and Child Early (PACE) Coaching Research Project to eligible families. The Project is aimed at parents of toddlers age 15-36 months with social and communication delays that put them at risk for autism. **You might be worried if a child you know:**

- ❖ **Doesn't** smile or use other joyful expressions
- ❖ **Doesn't** enjoy back and forth sharing of words or gestures
 - ❖ **Doesn't** point, show you things, or look at you to share
- ❖ **Doesn't** make speech sounds, talk, or put two words together by the time you expect
 - ❖ **Stopped** making speech sounds, talking, or interacting
